The course instructor will be **Dr. John Paul**. Dr. Paul has been specializing in composting and organic waste management for more than 20 years, and has taught more than 20 Compost Facility Operator Courses since 2007!

- Biological, physical and chemical fundamentals
- Properties of feedstock material and amendments
- Basic calculations and monitoring techniques

Practical exercise: Building your own compost pile

DAY TWO Composting Systems, Operation and Equipment

- Categories (static/agitated; open/enclosed systems; positive and negative aeration).
- Temperature, oxygen, and moisture control and management
- Pathogen control
- Equipment: grinder, mixer, turner, screener; aeration systems

- Causes, management and control technologies of environmental pollutants, with emphasis on odor and leachate control

Practical exercise: Monitoring temperature, moisture and oxygen; sampling

DAY THREE Legislation, Product Quality and Safety Aspects

- Acts, regulations, bylaws.
- Product quality and standards; compost properties, stability and maturity; sampling and testing
- Record keeping
- Staff and visitor safety; contingency measures and prevention

Marketing and public relations

- Economics, publicity, communication, press, public information; complaint and response

A small multiple-choice test at the end of the course will help you evaluate your new knowledge.

Cost for the course is \$ 595 (plus GST) includes refreshment breaks and three lunches.
